### Agenda/minutes

- All minutes from the CG meetings are now published online
- Towards a better inclusion of the extended Core Group members
  - Some WG leaders systematically inform their co-leaders. Some were included in examining the WG applications
  - TODO: send the CG minutes systematically to the unidive-ext-core list
- WG meeting in Istanbul
  - Date: 7 or 8 Sept 2023? Both days are regular working days in Turkey; CG members expressed some preference for Friday
  - Which WG?
    - Onsite meeting for one WG, online meetings (before or after) for other WGs in the same week (to create some momentum)
    - Inviting WG3 to Istanbul would be natural given Gülşen's WG3 vice-leader role
  - CG proposal:
    - Friday, 8th September 2023
    - WG3 on-site, WG1-2-4 meeting online in the same week
    - This proposal should be validated by an MC vote
- Budget
  - First installment of the year 1 budget (62500 EUR, 50% of year 1 budget) reached the Grant Holder recently
  - The next 30%+20% will be sent upon mid-year reports
- Feedback from examining WG applications
  - o 207 validated applications so far; all added to unidive-all and unidive-wg1/2/3/4
  - New WG applications still arriving (a few per week); Dan looks into them and validates those which seem relevant (see also the Google doc with <u>documented</u> <u>procedures</u>)
  - A short list of border cases unsure how to handle them
    - We might just not reject/accept them and wait for the candidates to recontact us with more details
    - WG leaders might contact those people to ask for further details
    - Proposal: Let's put irrelevant applications on hold

- Dan sent the list of 6 non-validated applications to unidive-core. CG members may express their opinion about them.
- Feedback from the STSM and conference grant calls
  - STSM call for applications and for hosting institutions have been published (on unidive-all and on the <u>website</u>)
  - Some clarifications questions arose:
    - An STSM can go to any country, not necessarily a COST country
    - The STSM guest must be from a COST or Near-Neigbor country
  - Depending on the number of applications, we might need selection criteria (do we prefer the host institution to be in a COST/NN country? should the hosting institution have a member from UniDive?)
- Brainstorming about organizing Paris-Saclay meeting and selection for reimbursement general ideas:
  - o PARSEME-like schedule
    - 1-day scientific workshop with invited talks and posters
      - TODO: draft a call, set up a submission space (easychair?), PC + chairs, deadline for applications, notifications
    - 1-day parallel WG meetings + 1 Extended Core Group meeting
  - o To do in parallel: a poll about expression of interest from potential attendees
  - Discussion:
    - [MARIE] Mid-January for abstract submission is too early (only mature work could be submitted by then; ACL deadline on 20 Jan),
    - [VERGINICA] WG2 ideas
      - Call for participation in WG2-related work, with the aim of having input for WG2 year 1 activity
      - Later: having 2-people teams working on each selected topic;
        maybe having 2 subgroups within WG2
    - [JOAKIM] Maybe a mixture of global and per-WG organization
      - Joint call, joint pool of submissions
    - [OLESEA] Should we invite more PC members (e.g. each ECG invites 1 more person) to speed up reviewing
    - [CARLOS] People should contribute a bit before the meeting to show their motivation; maybe an abstract on not only complete work but also future contributions, visions, etc.
  - Proposal
    - Important dates:
      - Submission of abstracts: 2 Feb 2023
      - Notification: 16 Feb
      - Official invitations of authors to the meeting:
    - PC co-chairs: Agata, Carlos, Joakim, Atul (willing to help with easy-chair)
    - Draft and send out a call before Christmas, send a reminder early January and late January
    - Talk to the Ext Core Group about being members of the PC
- Brainstorming about the expectations survey

- See <u>extracts from WG applications</u>
- o [MARIE] Maybe we should deal with it after the Paris-Saclay meeting
- [OLESEA] Maybe there should be one survey for each WG (she is ready to help with online forms)
- o [MARIE, JOAKIM] One survey with sub-sections for particular WGs
- [DAN] Have something more or less ready just before the March meeting, completing it after the meeting
- [AGATA] Let's add this to the CG agenda in January
- [JOAKIM] Feedback from the COST webinar on Open Research Europe
  - Publishing platform (original publishing venue, like a journal, not like ArXiv), peer review process, everything is non-anonymous (authors, reviewers); with 2 positive reviews, a paper is approved and is sent to publication
  - o Interesting model but with many competing publication channels
  - Probably not good as official publication channel for UniDive but might be interesting for some papers
- Pushed to the next meeting agenda:
  - Plan a storing space for all documents of the action
  - Science Communication Plan to draft until March 2023
