Agenda/minutes

- [AGATA: 5 min] Extra budget from COST::
 - Where to put it (email discussion)
 - Paris and Istanbul meetings this is the beginning of the Action, funding bigger meetings has impact on more people (Dan, Marie, Stella, Verginica, Joakim, Atul, Gülşen, Nurit)
 - STSMs with less priority (Dan, Stella)
 - Estimation by Beata:
 - 34,500 networking + 5,175 (FSAC) = 39,675 EUR (maximum to be requested is 40,000 EUR)
 - Networking would be decomposed a follows:
 - Paris-Saclay General Meeting (16-17 March): 10 people more + 200 EUR LOS; 10000 EUR ⇒ 80 reimbursed invitees
 - Istanbul WG3 meeting: 20 people more ⇒ 38 reimbursed; 16400 EUR
 - Decide after the WG3 meeting at Paris-Saclay (is
 - Should another WG meet also in Istanbul?
 - Talk to Gulsen
 - Or: meeting for another WG (a bit late to plan?)
 - o More STSMs: 8100 EUR
 - Giuseppe: no objection to the proposed plan. The completion of all grant agreement amendments will take some time, most likely until the end of April. So, the additional budget will be secured at some point but I cannot guarantee exactly when. Since the requested top-up fits in the range I initially provided (35k-40k EUR), I see very low risks that this amount cannot be granted. My suggestion is to include the extra invitations for the Paris meeting already, before the amendment is started. This

would result in an estimated over-spending compared to your initial plan. However, once you submit the updated work and budget plan you will adjust the figures and this will no longer appear as an over-spending.

- Decision: wait until shortly after Paris-Saclay to decide if we extend the WG3 meeting or invite another WG to Istanbul
- [NURIT: 10 minutes] Reporting about the selected STSMs, allocated budget
 - 14 applications, one for October too late to fix the budget (re-submission recommended); 32,600 EUR requested; available budget 13,600 EUR (+ 8,100 EUR with the top-up)
 - 2 STSM hosting offers 8 proposals (2 submitted to both)
 - Rules
 - Priority for YRI,
 - 1 STSM per person, no more than 2 per institution, lowering some amounts if needed
 - Rough estimation: 200 EUR/travel, 100 EUR/day
 - \circ Outcome: 6 people 10,650 EUR \rightarrow (+1) 14,000 EUR
 - o 6 on standby, 2 rejections (2 proposals per person)
 - No sure if a new call for year 1 is needed (some STSMs on standby are planned for July; if part of the budget left from Paris-Saclay, we might re-send a call)
 - Surely 1 call at the end of year 1 for STSMs in year 2
 - o Future process: WG leaders might express interest in particular STSMs
- [OLESEA: 10 minutes] Reporting about communication
 - A <u>survey</u> about communication issues was prepared, to be sent out soon. It includes
 - A call for expressions of interest in building the expectations survey
 - Inquiry about a storing space for all documents of the action, and about instantaneous communication like Mattermost, etc.
 - Other issues
 - Feedback from Core Group needed by the end of the week
 - A contest for a logo to be announced soon, 1000 EUR in year 1 budget to this aim
- [35 min.] Paris-Saclay meeting
 - [PC CHAIRS] Abstracts
 - 66 submissions, 1 withdrawn, 40 selected
 - Presentation form for the abstract all as posters or should any of them go to a WG session?
 - Random split into 2 groups are OK
 - Ask for 1 slide (1 minutes)
 - Should we try to publish the proceedings on Open Research Europe (?) -
 - Advantage: a permanent repository for abstracts
 - Should abstract go through another review process?
 - [AGATA] Expressions of interest (overlap with abstract co-authors)
 - 128 EOIs
 - Only 14 EOIs from the Extended Core Group

- [AGATA: 10-15 min.] E-cost invitations
 - See the <u>spreadsheet</u>, column X (to invite)
 - Rationale for column X
 - Self-funded people marked 0-Self-funded in column X, invited but not reimbursed
 - Abstract presenters + ECG members + Beata marked 1-Yes in column X
 - Local participants: LISN, Paris, close to Paris, with no accommodation, only short/middle distance costs - marked
 2-Maybe
 - People with leading roles in the communities and seminal works marked 2-Maybe
 - The others chosen so as to balance the percentage of YRI, countries and gender, and have the most "Yes" columns in columns I (Inclusiveness), P (MC) and R (abstract co-authors); I also looked at their WG applications - marked 3-Balance
 - The rest: YRI marked as 4-2nd round, others marked as 5-3rd-round
 - Adjusting and validating the list of the invited people (vote)
 - **Vote**: All in favor of the selection
 - In case of cancellation, we we invite new people with 4-2nd-round prioritizing YRIs and WG4
 - Abigail should submit an EOI she will be added to the list -DONE
- o (Close-to final) schedule
 - Invited talks about the foundations of UniDive (UD/PARSEME)
 - Recent developments in UD (Joakim, Marie, Dan) based on "10 years of UD" (talk at the UD workshop) and perspectives
 - PARSEME meets UD (who would present?)
 - Ryan Coterell from UniMorph to be included in UniDive
 - Boosters + poster sessions; division into 2 sessions (no particular criterion)
 - Hybrid mode probably possible (to confirm early March by Agata) do we want to use it in plenary sessions and WG sessions (some candidates asked for it)?
 - Make the plenaries + boosters hybrid
 - WG1-WG4 do not want to go hybrid (the format is very interactive)
 - WG sessions

 - [JOAKIM: 3-5 min.] WG3 see (planned) email to WG members, see also a WG3 survey
