 - [OLESEA] Other actions ask professionals to do it
 - [AGATA] Maybe in budget year 3?
- [VERGINICA: 5 min.] Feedback from the [COST workshops](#) on EC research policy:
 - Science for Policy WS: Engaging with policy makers (at local, national, European level) early in the duration of the action and keeping them co-interested
 - Inviting Maria (ELE) to the Istanbul meeting was a good example
 - Could we think of other such people whom we could involve? Maybe at the national level (talk to the MC).
 - Science Diplomacy training: diplomacy in science: in international collaboration, with reasons such as access (knowledge and technology elsewhere), promotion (of own achievements abroad) or influence (other country's public opinion and leaders); SD uses strategic (policies, strategic docs), operational (cooperations, boards, networks, S&T events) and supporting (trainings, awareness building events with policymakers, personal networking) tools
 - Concrete steps to take by UniDive not quite clear at this stage
- [AGATA: 5 min.] Confirming the dates for the 2nd General Meeting in Naples:
 - the WG1 Meeting on **Wednesday 7 Feb**
 - the 2nd General Meeting on **Thursday-Friday 8-9 Feb**
- [AGATA: 5 min.] Choosing the dates for the 1st Training School in Jerusalem:
 - The poll showed preference for 29/07-2/08 but this slot is impossible for Chaya after all
 - Remaining slots:
 - July 8-12 2024
 - July 15-19 2024
 - No issues about both slots from the CG

- [MARIE] Should we first find trainers and then decide about the slot?
- [BEATA: 5 min.] Current state of year 1 budget
 - The cost of the Istanbul meeting: 30 900 EUR (including LOS 2000 EUR)
 - In the budget for meetings we still have 9700 EUR
 - STSMs, we still have 4555 EUR
 - Conferences 530 EUR
 - For dissemination we spend 7500 EUR (1000 logo, 500 Olesea, 6000 website) instead of 3000
 - Savings - dissemination = **10 000 EUR** (we still have that amount to spend)
 - STSMs still possible until **15 Oct**
 - Olesea might be interested in submitting a proposal

 - Set up a framework and workflow for documenting multilingual language technology tools within the scope of UniDive.
 - Launch at least one multilingual evaluation campaign promoting universality and diversity in language technology.

 - Devise a "diversity" measure to be used in the WG3 shared task
 - [OLESEA] Communication - any specific goals?
