## Agenda/minutes

- [RANKA, VICTORIA, JOHANNA] 2nd General Meeting in Naples
  - Workshop
    - [RANKA, VICTORIA] Submissions, reviews
      - 40 accepted abstracts, 12 rejected, ranking by average score, with a threshold, crossed with the Eol form
      - People not having filled in the Eol form and having borderline abstracts were contacted personally
      - 1 complaint might be reconsidered
      - Thanks to Atul for his help!
    - Selected abstracts
      - Admit additional space for authors to take the reviewers' comments into account.
      - Use Open Review to collect posters
    - [OLESEA] Templates for posters (proposed but not compulsory)
      - pptx templates: <u>Template 1</u>, <u>Template 2</u>
    - List of selected abstracts see the link sent by Ranka
    - Invited speakers
      - François Yvon
      - Beata Wójtowicz & Martin Benjamin
  - Program
    - Time slots assumed similar to Paris-Saclay
    - Remarks from the WG leaders about parallel sessions on day 3
      - [MARIE-CATHERINE] Parallel WG sessions are OK
      - [JOAKIM] Maybe avoid parallel sessions of WG pairs which have the largest intersection
      - [VERGINICA] Same, in particular avoid WG1/WG2 overlap

- [VICTORIA] Simultaneous interest in WG1 and WG3 groups shows in the EoI form
- [BRUNO] WG1 has the whole day, day 3 as a summary (1 meeting on day 3?)
- [VERGINICA] WG1 and WG2 joint session?
- How about joint WG sessions?
  - Might be a good idea, at least for the afternoon sessions
  - The WG leaders should discuss the idea of joint sessions and send the needs to Agata and Dan by early January
- Do we need hybrid sessions?
  - From Johanna: One of the rooms in Naples will be equipped for hybrid meeting
  - WG1 is planning hybrid sessions on day 1
- Invitations sent out to round 1 (leaders), ongoing for rounds 2 (poster presenters)
- [WG LEADERS: early January] Discuss the need of joint sessions; send feedback to Agata and Dan
- [OLESEA] How to ask for authorisation for publishing photos from Naples?
  - If a registration form will be used, include a question about it.
    - Or use a list to sign onsite.
- [AGATA, DAN] Draft program by 10 January
- [MARIE-CATHERINE] Shall we coordinate going to the same hotel? If anyone has a proposal, please, suggest.
  - [AGATA] Make sure with Beata that staying longer is OK for daily allowance.
- [JOAKIM] Need for more coordination among WGs
  - The need comes up almost in every WG3 meeting: some tasks are similar to others, some task leaders or participants are confused
  - Do we need another channel for coordination among WG leaders?
  - [BRUNO] At least one WG leaders' meeting extra?
  - [VERGINICA] We need an easy access to current progress of each task in each WG
  - [BRUNO] Maybe create links rather at the task level
  - [JOAKIM] While discussion the joint WG sessions in Naples, the overlap in tasks will necessarily pop up
- [VOULA, JOAKIM] <u>MWE-UD workshop</u>, Turin
  - [AGATA] Make sure COST is appropriately acknowledged see the <u>COST rules</u> p. 78 (case: "Co-organisation of Action events with and external organization"). This is **not** currently the case:
    - UniDive is marked as sponsor, not a co-organizer
    - There is no link to the UniDive website
    - The COST identity is not respected
    - Ideally have a session explicitly named a UniDive session (this will of course depend on the submissions)
  - [VOULA] More organizational details

- 1st CfP already released
- Precise date: 25th May
- Submission page not yet ready (waiting for LREC workshop chairs),
- Notification: 1 Apr around this date we'll start discussing reimbursements
- [AGATA] Add the discussion about funding authors with the UniDive budget around 1/04
- [ATUL] <u>2nd Workshop on Resources and Technologies for Indigenous.</u> <u>Endangered and Lesser-resourced Languages in Eurasia (EURALI)</u> also accepted at LREC/COLING. How could we join forces?
  - [ATUL] Maybe a joint invited speaker or panel among the 2 workshops
  - [VOULA] The discussion about these convergences started
  - [JOAKIM] The MWE-UD workshop is already getting crowded due to bringing together 3 initiatives. We'll have to see how many submissions are received/selected.
- 1st Training School in Jerusalem (July 8-12) recent progress
  - Course 1: Starting a (S)UD treebank for a new language
    - Sylvain agrees, would like the trainees to come with a tokenized, glossed and translated corpus; would use Arborator Grew
    - Francis unavailable to come but interested in co-organising the course.
      He shared these <u>slides</u> (in Spanish) from a 1-week course in Mexico City on developing UD corpora aimed at Indigenous peoples of the Americas.
    - Dedicated online meeting: Sylvain, Francis, Agata, who else?
  - Course 2: Starting a PARSEME corpus for a new language
    - Verginica, Voula agreed to teach; they have a first meeting on the 5th of January
  - Course 3: Transfer learning for low-resourced languages
    - Ivan not yet contacted; should we propose 2 trainers for this course, e.g. Ivan and Lonneke, for less workload and more gender balance?
    - Leave the choice to Ivan.
  - Course 4: Corpus annotation infrastructure
    - [BRUNO] Linking the WG1 survey on annotation tools with the choice of the tools to teach
    - [MARIE-CATHERINE] Knows people in Mexico who would need output from this module - make the material (slides, exercises, recordings) available
    - [AGATA] This is already planned (maybe not the recordings, which would be too large)
  - Hackathon: Brainstorming on topics submitted by the trainees
    - To organize when the selection of the trainees is ongoing
  - How to recruit the trainees?
    - An Eol form + balance criteria
- Forthcoming <u>deliverables</u> content, WGs involvement, deadlines
  - Aline will look into what is expected when

- Towards a strategy from integrating experts of low-resourced languages already planned as a task
  - Beware of overlap in this task between WG1 and WG4
- Any other business
  - Avoid simultaneous online meetings of different tasks/WGs maybe a joint Google calendar?
  - [OLESEA] Need to explain some communication rules to the action members. In Naples?
    - [AGATA] The Naples schedule is quite tight. Also, most members will not be there. Maybe prepare a written document, to send per email and display on the website
