Agenda

- [WG LEADERS: 20 min.] Issues from WG activities and WG interactions
 - [VERGINICA WG2]
 - Several ongoing tasks: wordhood survey; ELEXIS parallel corpus; survey on MWE lexicons (to turn into a book chapter); community survey on using MWE lexicons in NLP tasks; new task on harmonizing lemmatization rules; new task on MWE canonical forms (with Jan Odijk as a new member)
 - All tasks have rather regular meetings + monthly WG2 meetings
 - Need for synergies with WG1 wrt. lexicon-corpus interface task need for more details about new guidelines for annotating non-verbal MWEs.
 - [MARIE-CATHERINE WG4]
 - 3 subtasks: promoting low-resource languages (from educational perspective); survey of measures of language diversity (proposal sent to Computational Linguistics); measure for shared task diversity
 - Paper by Miryam de Lhoneux and colleagues on arxiv currently developing a measure of typological diversity for a shared task (a PhD student, Esther Ploeger, presented their current work) => potential synergy with WG3
 - [JOAKIM WG3]
 - Meeting last week
 - 3 ongoing tasks; slow but steady progress in at least 2 tasks: shared task (early July - first version of data for English + script for UD conversion); conceptual investigation about multi-/cross-linguality (survey results being analysed)
 - documentation task non moving (3 out of 4 co-leaders stepped down);
 bottom-up approach did not work very well; one possible reason might be
 that WG3 is heavily affected by the recent developments in NLP, with focus

on LLMs; Should we report on the modest progress or should we redefine the task? To discuss after the summer.

 - Meeting last week
 - Task 1.1 (typology-related): New task leader (Flavio), redefining the task
 - Task 1.2 (MWE annotation): Ongoing discussion on Gitlab, new guidelines to publish
 - Task 1.3 (morphosyntactic guidelines): Overlap with previous discussions on UD Github
 - Task 1.4 (tools): A bit behind the schedule
 - New task 1.5: Annotation of spoken data (Sylvain and Kaja as co-leaders)
- Potential WG3-WG1 synergy in UD treebank conversion for the WG3 shared task
 - Slides (p. 14-15) presenting the idea of the annotation scheme
 - Potential of using Grew-match for corpus conversion
 - Making graph rewriting rules as generic a possible, to be re-usable from one language to another
 - Emails already exchanged between Bruno, Joakim and Omer
 - [BRUNO] Probably easy to do with Grew to discuss with Omer in Moldova
 - [DAN] Also possible with Udapi (Dan's student is already doing something similar) also to discuss in Moldova
 - [JOAKIM] Saving time is not the most crucial; more important: lowering the bar for the people to enter this task; user support also needed
- [BEATA, AGATA] Top-up budget
 - Budget year 2 amendment, with extended budget, drafted late April; approved by COST and the MC mid-May
 - Total budget 243,000 EUR (initial budget: 218,000 EUR; extension by 25,000 EUR
 = 11.5%)
 - Budget increase per event:
 - MWE-UD workshop (from 7,200 EUR to 23,040 EUR)
 - Training School (from 72,800 EUR to 84,210 EUR)
 - ITC or Dissemination Conference Grant (from 1,500 EUR to 4,500 EUR)
- [VOULA] MWE-UD workshop summary
 - o 1 day event, 26 accepted archival submissions
 - Interesting program, well balanced across the 3 tracks (MWE, UD, MWE/UD)
 - Opening and closing session slides, with other statistics and announcements, will be available soon
 - o Registration numbers: 3rd biggest event co-located with LREC-COLING
 - LREC-COLING and ACL working towards giving doi identifiers to workshop proceedings
 - ACL anthology might add data on best paper awards in workshops
 - MWE section of SIGLEX preparing the next event (not with COLING but rather at ACL 2025, which is in Europe).
 - Could we have support from UniDive again?

- Synergies planned but not yet decided
 - UD workshop will be part of SyntaxFest 2025 (Ljubliana, dates not yet decided)
- Shared task possible but not sure to have the data ready
- ACL not very happy that the MWE workshop was not co-located with an ACL event
- [BEATA] Budget of the workshop (23,040), savings (23,040 18,348 = ~4,692 EUR)
- 1st Training School in Chişinău (July 8-12) latest news
 - o [ATUL] Project submissions: 57 submission, selected 56
 - [BEATA, AGATA] Selection of the trainees, confirmations, budget (75,710 + LOS 8,500)
 - 52 participants eligible for the reimbursement + 7 trainers; (still waiting for 2 answers about the student status)
 - 63 trainees total, 51 accepted invitations by now
 - [VICTORIA, OLESEA] Local organisation
 - A1 poster sizes (another floor than the courses)
 - How much could be spent on coffee breaks? => LOS = 8500 EUR, split as needed but must be justified with invoices and timesheets
 - Invitations sent to people with visas
 - Progress on social events: top attractions and social events <u>Here</u>
 - Registration form is in progress
 - [Olesea] Accepted projects, published on webpage <u>here</u>
 - o [Olesea] Poster Templates Here. Mailing in progress.
 - [AGATA] <u>Schedule</u>, with interactions between the 3 courses
 - Recording the lectures modalities to decide
- [NURIT] STSMs
 - o 2nd call:
 - 5 STSMs granted
 - 3 female, 2 male
 - 2 ITC, 3 non-ITC
 - Assigned budget 10,400 EUR
 - Remaining budget 3,865 EUR
 - o Plan a last-minute (after Chisinau) all like last year
 - STSM beneficiary can ask for up to 50% budget before the event write to Beata
- [AGATA] 3rd general meeting in Budapest (Hungarian Research Centre for Linguistics)
 - Dates

 - 29-30 Jan 2025: General Meeting
 - Proposals of PC chairs
 - Veronika Lipp accepted

- [ATUL] Ranka should be able to handle Open Review
- [ATUL] Some documentation was drafted about Open Review, can share with UniDive

 - [AGATA] Consider age balance within the PC chairs
 - [MARIE-CATHERINE] Olha is well organized, but check if available for 2 events (for continuation)
- [OLESEA] She is also available to co-chair, would like to also learn about Open Review

- [JOAKIM, GÜLŞEN: 10 min.] WG3 shared task on Morpho-Syntactic Analyso-Parsing -2025 venues
 - SyntaxFest 2025 Ljubliana; 5 conferences on syntax (TLT, DepLing, UDW, IWPT, CxGs+NLP) dates to decide
 - → SemEval excluded (deadline passed)
 - CONLL no shared task this year; plans to resume in 2025; the dates are also unclear
 - o The choice depends on the timing SyntaxFest is the first choice if not too early
- [AGATA: 5 min.] Year 3 budget
 - First draft here
 - 2 onsite events (Budapest, shared task culmination)
 - More money to STSMs and conferences
 - Any need for a 3rd onsite event?
 - [VOULA] Help organizing another MWE workshop in 2025
 - [VERGINICA] Can the UD workshop be supported?
 - [JOAKIM] In the ST is part of the event, then the UD workshop is already covered
 - Split the 50-person shared task budget into the 2 workshops UD and MWE
- [ALINA: 5 min.] Mid-term evaluation => reschedule
 - New task 1.5 which deliverables should be assigned to this task => to discuss with the task leaders
 - Deliverables spreadsheet is up to date
 - [AGATA] Should collect feedback from event participants (see a sample <u>form</u> collecting feedback from a PARSEME meeting)? Should we have a mid-term satisfaction survey? => discuss next time
