## Agenda

- [MWE-UD workshop](#) - latest news
  - [VOULA] 52 submissions in 3 tracks (MWE, UD, MWE/UD), reviewing just started
  - Potential authors for funding - expression of interest will be requested after the reviewing
  - Acceptance rate in the past: UD usually 50%, MWE - sometimes 60%, sometimes 23%. We might try to keep this rate high enough for larger diversity.
  - [NURIT] Should the conference grants also go to the MWE-UD workshop?
    - [NURIT] This budget is quite low:
      - ITC Conference grants budget: 1,000 EUR
      - Dissemination Conference grants: 500 EUR
      - Last year we gave two ITC grants, total of 970 EUR (conference fee + 1 COST daily allowance)
    - OK to promote the workshop for these grants
  - Eligible expenses:
    - The workshop is encoded in the budget as a meeting
    - Registration fee is not reimbursed
    - Travel is reimbursed, also for the main conference (several days before the workshop)
    - Daily allowance for ~2 days
  - [VOULA] SIGLEX agreed to allocate some money to the MWE-UD workshop
- [1st Training School](#) in Chişinău (July 8-12) - latest news
  - MC vote - relocation to Chişinău validated unanimously
  - Trainers & courses
    - Course 1 - annotating a (S)UD treebank for a new language
      - Confirmed by Sylvain Kahane
    - Course 2 - annotating MWEs in a new language

- Confirmed by Verginica and Voula
    - Course 3 - transfer learning for low-resourced languages
      - Ivan, Lonneke, Tanja - declined
      - Miryam - will probably decline but is still considering (until March 20)
      - If Miryam declines - 3 possible other solutions
        - Other experts to contact
        - Publish a call for course trainers
        - Skip the course this time, focus more on corpus annotation - preferred solution
    - Course 4 - corpus annotation infrastructure (annotation platforms, format validators, Git etc.) - first ideas from Bruno, Dan and Agata
  - Brainstorming **hackaton** on topics submitted by the trainees => maybe to be gathered together with the projects (open questions people face in their projects)
  - Victoria proposed also a **poster** session
  - Discussion
    - [VICTORIA] Posters could be a criterion to select participants
    - [DAN] Another idea - effective addition of a new resource to UD/PARSEME
      - Submission of a project of a resource creation related to UD/PARSEME
    - [BRUNO] Preparing input data for annotation (a few sentences with glosses & translations) is already a pre-requisite for Sylvain's course
    - [VOULA] Pre-requisites will already keep the trainees busy, we should not overload them with an new obligation.
    - [VICTORIA, JOAKIM] Posters are a great form to discuss one's work
    - Other selection criteria:
      - The resourcedness status of the language
      - Geographical and gender balance
      - YRI are preferred
  - What we finally propose as **input from the trainees**:
    - Each trainee should submit a project for a construction of a resource related to the topics of the training school
    - An open question related to the project can be submitted for the brainstorming hackaton
    - Optionally, the selected project can be presented as posters
- [ALL] Year 3 events
  - WG2 meeting + 3rd General Meeting + 3rd UniDive workshop - early 2025 (January-March)
    - Call sent out on 19/02
    - Veronika Lipp explicitly encouraged to submit a proposal (after consultation with Giuseppe), due to the training school relocation in 2023.
    - Proposals:
      - Budapest (Veronika Lipp)
      - Yerevan (Anna Danielyan)

- Malta (Lucienne Bugeja, via Claudia Borg)
  - Informal proposal from Theo Zacharis from Athens (*We can organise it in Athens, if there are no other proposals*). Voula and Stella were considering also submitting a proposal for Athens but it was too late to book convenient rooms. Maybe next year.
    - All in favor of **Budapest** (very central venue, good facilities, not too expensive, we promised to reconsider it)

  - SemEval excluded (deadline in 2 weeks)
  - CONLL - check the deadline
  - UD workshop
  - IWPT workshop
